

Acknowledgement of Understanding of the Contractor Agreement

The undersigned is an authorized representative of the Contractor named below ("Contractor"). By signing this agreement, is acknowledging, on behalf of Contractor, that the Contractor:

- Will comply with all applicable federal, Provincial and local environmental, health and safety regulations at all times;
- Has been provided and read the contents of the Arpac Storage Systems Corporation Contractor Health and Safety Package including manual, policies, "HR-001 - Fit for Duty Policy" and "HR-003 - Violence, Bullying, Harassment, and Discrimination Policy", and has had the opportunity to ask questions to ensure understanding of the contents;
- Has ensured all Contractor and Subcontractor personnel are aware of Arpac's safety policies and procedures including those outlines in the safety manual, "HR-001 - Fit for Duty Policy", and "HR-003 - Violence, Bullying, Harassment, and Discrimination Policy" and has had the opportunity to ask questions to ensure understanding of the contents;
- Has ensured that all Contractor and Subcontractor personnel are trained to safely perform their assigned tasks and possess any required up-to-date training qualifications, certifications, or licenses, including but not limited to trade certificates, welding, working in confined spaces, WHMIS, TDG, use of aerial lifts, and electrical lockout and tag-out;
- Will immediately report to the site contact all health or safety incidents, complaints, or work refusals. Arpac requires Contractors to investigate these and provide the final report including corrective actions;
- Will ensure their Certificate of Insurance remains valid, and will notify Arpac immediately if this coverage changes;
- Will ensure their personnel/sub-contractors present on Arpac sites have Worker's Compensation coverage, and will notify Arpac immediately if this coverage changes;
- Has/ will provide all requirements outlined in the Contractor Pre-Qualification;
- Has/ will provide SDS Sheets for any related items brought onto Arpac sites;
- Will ensure that all work completed at this site by Contractor and Subcontractor personnel is completed in a manner that meets or exceeds all the health and safety guidelines of Arpac Storage Systems Corporation and applicable legislation;
